- \* Advanced Exterior Industrial Fire Brigade Member (40 hrs) - Course #IND016
- \* Interior Structural Industrial Fire Brigade Member (40 hrs) - Course #IND017
- \* Industrial Fire Brigade Leader (16 hrs) - Course #IND103

This standard identifies the minimum job performance requirements (JPRs) necessary to perform the duties as a member of an organized industrial fire brigade providing services at a specific facility or site.

## Course Overview

The course provides emergency response personnel with a solid foundation of knowledge and skills that may be used to safely resolve an emergency in a plant facility in compliance with NFPA 1081. Students will gain confidence in their abilities to handle a variety of emergency situations through classroom and field exercises.

**Location:** Training can be conducted at Brayton Fire Training Field in its entirety or the classroom portion can be delivered at the customer's site. These courses can also be conducted at an approved facility in their entirety.
