

TEXAS FIRE OFFICER PROGRAM

REAL-WORLD TRAINING PROVIDED BY EXPERIENCED FIRE OFFICERS

The Texas Fire Officer Program is a comprehensive fire officer training program offered by TEEX Emergency Services Training Institute to all Texas fire service personnel. The program consists of NFPA 1021-based Fire Officer courses (Fire Officer I, II, III & IV).

Prerequisites: Fire Officer I - Firefighter II & Fire Instructor I
Fire Officer II - Fire Officer I & Fire Instructor I
Fire Officer III - Fire Officer II & Fire Instructor II
Fire Officer IV - Fire Officer III & Fire Instructor II

Certification: All courses meet NFPA 1021 and Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP) guidelines. Students successfully completing the Fire Officer I, II, III & IV programs receive Pro Board (NPQS) NFPA 1021 certification and are eligible for American Council on Education (ACE) credit. Students completing Fire Officer I & II may also obtain TCFP certification.

Location: Courses will be conducted at one of the hosted training sites in Texas or the U.S., at one of the TEEX regional training sites, or at the world-renowned Brayton Fire Training Field in College Station.

Tuition: Fire Officer I & II \$150 for Texas residents, \$600 for non-Texas residents.
Fire Officer III & IV \$300 for Texas residents. \$800 for non-Texas residents.
Out-of-State TEEX Fire Officer courses can be delivered on-site at your location.
