Structure Fire Fighting (Saturday or Sunday)	PPE/ SCBA	PREREQUISITE: EXPERIENCE WITH AIR PACKS Search & Rescue, Hose Handling, Fire Streams, Ventilation, Containment & Extinguishment.	8
Fire Fighting Evolutions - Basic (Saturday or Sunday)	PPE/ SCBA	Hose Handling, Vehicle Fire, Portable Extinguishers, LPG-Tank, Christmas Tree, Flame Impingement, Flat Pit Spill Fire.	8
Fire Fighting Evolutions - Advanced (Saturday or Sunday)	PPE/ SCBA	Pipe Rack / Meter Loop, Tanker Manway, Well Head, Pump Seal, Elevated Structure, Advance students will work each as a team with OIC's from the student ranks and mitigate each scenario with the equipment and personnel they have available at the time. Advance students would work their allotted time as necessary to complete the scenario.	8
Hazardous Materials: Common Everyday Incidents (Two Days, Sat & Sun.)	PPE/ SCBA	This class covers incidents that the fire service may encounter on a day to day operation. During the class participants will go over means to mitigate incidents. This class will consist of classroom and hands on techniques.	16
Rope Rescue Awareness (High Angle & Confined) (Two Days, Sat & Sun)	PPE	Covers Rescue Equipment, Ropes, Knots, Repelling, Raises & Lowers Haul Systems, Telfer Lines, Anchors & Anchor Point, Knot Passing Confined Space Entry & Rescue.	16
Rookie Class (Two Days, Sat & Sun)	PPE/ SCBA	This course is designed for new fire fighters. It contains, SCBA, Protective Clothing, Hose Handling, Fire Stream Practices & Fire Extinguishment.	16
Forcible Entry (Two Days, Sat & Sun)	PPE	Conventional Forcible Entry, Through the Lock Methods, Pad Locks, Overhead Doors and Other Special Entry Problems. Students will be able to use hand & power tools to breach walls, cut through metal & break through concrete. Protective equipment will be needed for breaching, cutting & breaking operation.	16
Vehicle Extrication Technician – Level – I & II (Two 1/2 Days) **Starts Friday at 6p	PPE	Covers all Objectives as defined in SFFMA's Vehicle Extrication Technician I & II (in accordance with NFPA1006)	20
NOTE: Fire Fighting, Rookie & Hazardous Materials Classes		Please bring air packs for Fire Fighting, Rookie, and Hazardous Materials Classes	

**PPE / SCBA must be NFPA-approved. All participants must wear long pants and shirts with sleeves. NFPA Compliant full protective clothing shall be worn on all burn projects. No beards will be permitted on SCBA required projects.*

Rope Rescue Awareness: Requires - Ansi - Head Protection, Clear Eye Protection, & Leather Gloves.

Vehicle Extrication: Bunker gear or extrication gear (NO Wildland gear), ANSi approved head protection (i.e. fire helmet, hardhat), Face shield/goggles or ANSi approved safety glasses, Fire gloves or approved rescue gloves (NO mechanic gloves), Boots with toe protection (i.e. steel toed).
