Firefighters will need to bring their own Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus and NFPA / OSHA approved protective equipment including firefighter's helmet with chin strap; face shield and hood; short firefighters coat with vapor liner; firefighter's pants with a vapor liner; short firefighter boots; canvas, leather or Nomex type gloves (no plastic). Participants must also meet OSHA requirements for wearing SCBA. Beards or long sideburns in the face piece seal area are prohibited. No exceptions. All students must be 18 years of age. **Absolutely no shorts or sleeveless shirts will be permitted.**
