PACKAGE E: Basic ropes	8 a.m. – 5 p.m.	*	Course covers basic knot tying, anchoring points and use of various hauling systems and rappelling	8

**PPE / SCBA must be NFPA-approved. Full bunker gear including helmet with faceshield or NFPA-approved goggles, safety glasses, gloves and boots.*

***Students in Packages A and B should wear any gear suitable for heavy brush (no camo or bunker gear or western-style boots). Students should bring a light-weight helmet with chinstrap, eye protection, sunscreen, gloves, rugged footwear, highly visible clothing. A recommended personal equipment pack containing flat-faced compass, GPS units and instruction manual, small personal first aid kit, canteen, water bottle or camelback, duct tape or moleskin for prevention of blisters. Wildland firefighting gear is suitable. Other useful equipment would be radios with Mutual Aid channels A-B-C, rain gear and insect repellent.*
