**\*\* All students participating in Firefighting operations must bring their own NFPA or OSHA approved bunker gear. No one under the age of 18 will be allowed to participate in hands-on field operations. Participants must meet OSHA requirements for wearing SCBA face piece. Beards or long sideburns in the face piece seal are prohibited and also no jewelry, no sleeveless shirts, no shorts, no open toe shoes or sandals will be allowed.**
