FEE..... **SFFMA Module 4 (Firefighter II Advanced):** \$120 covers Monday – Sunday. This conference **covers a portion** of SFFMA Module 4 Firefighter II Advanced Certification required objectives. Pre-registration and payment for certification program required by April 20, 2012. No walk-ins.



SFFMA Vehicle Extrication Technician II: \$85 covers Saturday and Sunday. Pre-registration for Rescue School is not required, but strongly suggested by April 20th deadline.

Rescue School: \$50 covers Saturday and Sunday. Pre-registration for Rescue School is not required, but strongly suggested by April 20th deadline.
