



## GENERAL REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS

### **Basic Marine Firefighting Advanced Marine Firefighting, and Combined Marine Firefighting Courses**

- LOCATION:** Classroom sessions are conducted at the:

- CLASS TIMES:** - Basic Marine Firefighting & Combined Marine Firefighting will begin at 8:00 AM on Monday morning. All classes end at 5:00 pm.  
- Advanced Marine Firefighting will begin at 8:00 AM on Tuesday morning.
- PAYMENT FOR TUITION:** Tuition is required two weeks prior to class start date. We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, cash, check, and Purchase Order.
- IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:** All Students attending a U.S. Coast Guard approved course are now required to provide TEEX with a picture ID on the first day of class.  
Drivers License, MMD, Passport, Armed Forces ID, etc.
- DRESS:** In order to participate in interior firefighting projects, participants' facial hair must meet OSHA requirements for wearing Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA). Beards or long sideburns are not allowed. The student must be clean shaven except for mustaches, prior to attending class.
- Dress will be seasonal work clothing that the participant does not mind getting dirty. Shirts must have at least short sleeves and pants must be long. No open toed or slipper type shoes are allowed.
- RISK RELEASE:** Students will be required to sign a risk release form at the start of class. If you wish to review the risk release prior to the start of class; please check our web site at [www.teex.com/marine](http://www.teex.com/marine).
- MEALS:** Noon meals are included in the fee for all 8 hour training days. The fee does not include breakfast, dinner or lodging. All other meals may be purchased at local restaurants.
