Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I register for classes?

2. Why is there a difference in fees for in-State, and Out of State tuition?

Funding for classes conducted inside the State of Texas is offset by funding from the Texas tax dollars specifically to help defray the costs of Leadership Training conducted by TEEEX. The tuition fee of \$150.00 is used to offset some of the training costs. Full cost recovery is the fee Out of State residents pay for the class (\$455.00). Please note, that as a State Agency this does NOT include any “profit” margin.

3. Can I register on-line for classes?

Only for the on-line class offerings (EMS 802, 812, and 822). Because of the different fee schedules for in-state and out of state registration student, registration must be accomplished with the assistance of one of our customer service representatives.

4. Are certificates awarded for attending the classes?

Participants are awarded a class completion certificate for every class they successfully complete. In addition, those who successfully complete the full 40 hour class at all three levels (Basic Supervisory Practices, EMS System Management, and Executive Development) are awarded a certificate in EMS Leadership and Management signifying that they have successfully completed 120 hours of EMS Leadership and Management Training.

5. Can I mix the 24 hour and 40 hour classes and still receive the Certificate in EMS Management?

No. The Certificate in EMS Management is only issued for those who have successfully completed all three levels of the 40 hour classes.

6. Can I mix the on-line classes and the face to face classes and still be awarded the Certificate in EMS Management?

Yes. So long as you have successfully completed 40 hours of training at each level, for the full 120 hours of training, you may be awarded the Certificate in EMS Management.
