

## PER 211 Continuing Education Hours

The **Emergency Nurses Association** (ENA) will award 15.0 hours for full completion of the course. ENA will not give partial hours if any time is missed during the two day course. There is a specific sign in form for ENA and evaluation forms the nurses will complete in class at the end of the course. The PER 211 instructors will file these forms with ENA within 10 days of course completion.

The **American Academy of Family Physicians** (AAFP) also has a specific sign-in form that is completed in class the first day of the course. AAFP will not give partial hours if any time is missed during the two day course. TEEX will only file with AAFP if a physician attending the class requests that TEEX files on their behalf. Physicians that belong to another accrediting board can take the letter along with their certificate and file on their own.
